# TOUR PLANNER

Day 1 – Arrival at Borspol Airport Boryspol. Stop in downtown Kiev for a lunch in Ukrainian traditional restaurant. Arrive to Zhitomir for lodging in Reikartz hotel. (Please arrange for your arrival before 4pm local time)

Day 2 - Today we will visit Neuborn and Tcherniachov. We will stop the Office of Vital Statistics and will apply for Ted's birth certificate. We will go the farm site and interview some old people. We will come back to Zhiomir for Ukrainian dinner about 6 p.m.

Day 3 - Today we will visit Solodyri and Neudorf to see the TOLKMITT site. In Neudorf we will stop and visit German Baptist Church build and dedicated in 1907. It was the main mother church of Volyhnina German Baptist movement. In the afternoon we will go to Pulin to see SMU widows' house and there we will be treated with traditional Ukrainian borsh. We might consider visiting remains of Sorochen Baptist church. This is a unique wooden church still standing in the middle of the field. We will come back to Zhitomir for dinner.

Day 4 - Today we will go to Radomyshl to see the old paper factory and now the only museum of Icons, after we will visit the residence of ex-president Yanukocich. On the way to our hotel in Kiev we will stop in the Independence Square, where two last revolutions took place. We will overnight in Lybid Kiev hotel.

Day 5 - Today early in the morning we will visit Adrew's descent the best place to shop for the souvenirs. We will also see St Andew Church. It's believed that Apostle Andrew was the first who preached the gospel to the Slavic tribes back 2,000years ago. We will make our way to the airport for check in and boarding. PLEASE if you can arrange for the flight back to Europe or North American after 2pm se we come for checking at 12 and this will allow us to full fill morning plans.



# ADDITIONAL INFO

In between the cracks as time allows, we will visit open markets, cemeteries, churches, schools, and other points of historical interest to the group. We will also have time to interact with local villagers, enjoy various cultural interests, tourist attractions along the way, and see the country side. Much of rural Ukraine is still the way it was when our forefathers lived there -- people herding cows along the road, walking barefoot, driving with horse and wagon, though few German buildings remain. With some luck we might see one of the old wooden windmills that were so popular with the Germans.
